DOWNTOWN'S NEWEST OPEN SPACE... UNIQUE AND INTIMATE

A beautiful park is emerging that will add a new dimension to downtown and realize a vital component of the Downtown Now! plan. A space for performances, gatherings or quiet reflection, the Old Post Office Plaza will incorporate extensive landscaping and cascading water over a bronze sculpture "Torso di Ikaro," by internationally acclaimed artist Igor Mitoraj. Based on the Greek Myth of Daedalus and Icarus, the Plaza begins with a tree-covered Labyrinth, traverses into the Island of Thorns, crescendos with the Daedalus rise before concluding dramatically in the fall of Icarus in the water basin.

The Plaza includes an open space for performances, a stage, tiered seating and a wall for video displays. Surrounded by office buildings, restaurants, hotels and retail, the Plaza is an urban oasis for those wanting to have quiet conversations or read a book. At the same time, it offers all of the amenities of the ideal urban meeting place. Exemplifying the rebirth of downtown and complementing the revitalized historic Old Post Office, the Plaza is where hip meets classic and a journey begins.
